Livestream

Have you registered for the Summit via <https://summit.saveoneeurope.org/en>? When you have registered you will be sent a confirmation by email immediately. Please check in your Spam or Junk Mail folders if you cannot find this mail.

How do I take part?

The Summit will be sent out as a livestream via our *YouTube*® channels. We will send you an access link which can be used with any suitable device such as a PC, Laptop, Tablet or Smartphone.

Access Links

The links for the Summit will be sent out to you by email around 3 days prior to the Summit. Important: If you do not receive the link please also check your Spam and Junk Mail folders to be sure that it has not landed there.

The link will be active at the start of each Summit day (Vienna, Central European Time). Once you click the link, you will be directed to a page where you can choose to view the stream in English or German.

SaveOne in Europe



SaveOne was founded in 2000 by Sheila Harper. In 2004 it came to Europe or more specifically to Slovenia.

Since then, it has spread to 15 European countries that are supported and overseen from Vienna.

Worldwide, there are presently over 300 SaveOne leaders, including 14 Networkers spread across 26 countries for this ministry.

Get to know the Speakers



Sheila Harper is the founder and president of SaveOne, an international ministry helping men and women who are suffering in silence after an abortion.

Sheila has a master's degree in Biblical Counselling and has published six books: *"SaveOne – Workbook for Women"*, *"SaveOne – Workbook for Men"*, *"May I have this Dance? A Journal through Pregnancy"*, *"Is There Not a Cause?"*, *"Survivor"* which tells her own story of abortion and restoration, and her newest book, *"Finding You"* which is a workbook for individuals who experienced abuse. Sheila speaks on abortion worldwide and trains people who are working with post-abortive people. After suffering from her own decision to have an abortion, she found healing and forgiveness in Jesus Christ. Sheila and her husband Jack have two wonderful sons. Together they live in Nashville, Tennessee.



Jack Harper is the Vice President and Men's Director for SaveOne. He has worked in unity with SaveOne since 1999: *"Much of my early efforts were supporting the new ministry with finances and traveling with Sheila when possible. Over the years, the travel and ministry led me to men literally around the world who have been broken from the pain of abortion. Men have been told they have no say in this matter, men have been told that this is a woman's issue and they should remain silent and on the sidelines. Attempts to silence these men is coming to an end. My passion is to help lead men to the hope, healing, and restoration that only Jesus can give after an abortion. My passion is to restore the voice of fatherhood for those who lost children, whether they participated in the abortion decision or could do nothing to stop the process."* Since September 2018, Jack has resigned from pastoring CrossRoads Church in Antioch, TN, to fully devote his time to SaveOne global.



Sonja Horswell is the director of SaveOne Europe. She was the director of the pregnancy help centre *"Österreichische Lebensbewegung"* from 2001-2017 until SaveOne Europe became its own non-profit organization. Sonja is a visionary and pioneer and her passion is to reach the lost and the hurting people after abortion and see them saved and healed. She is trained in business, inner healing and pastoral care. Sonja began leading SaveOne courses and training facilitators in 2008. In 2010 she was given the responsibility of building up and overseeing SaveOne Europe. She, along with her husband Chris, works with couples to bring them to freedom after an abortion. They have an adult son, David.



Chris Horswell has been a SaveOne supporter and co-worker since its beginning in Austria. He started as Men’s Director in early 2017 to be a voice in Europe for fatherhood, for men, and the continuing sanctity of life. He leads courses for men, and contributes at conferences, workshops, exhibitions, as well as to the trainings and other public work of SaveOne. His heart is that men too experience healing and restoration and live out their God-given place as fathers, providers, carers and protectors of life.



Karissa Larson is the Communication Manager at SaveOne Europe and has been working with the team in Vienna for 1.5 years. She is originally from Seattle, Washington in the USA and has a degree from Seattle Pacific University in Elementary and Special Education. She has also completed two ministry training programs and is nearing completion of a certification in Christian Counseling. She is passionate about seeing broken people find emotional healing in Jesus and equipping followers of Christ to live the full and abundant life available to them. Aside from her work at SaveOne, she is on the core leadership team for a local church in Vienna and leads a prophetic ministry team.



Bethany Janzen ProLife Europe - What if we were able to reach women before they experienced a crisis pregnancy? What if we were able to actually change our culture? The proven way to do so is through reaching the youth; they are the most likely to change their hearts and are those targeted for abortion. Through school and university groups, ProLife Europe empowers the young generation to change hearts and save lives. We equip them to reach their peers through LifeTALKS in schools, outreach at Uni and on the streets, and via social media.

Previously leading a university group in the States and then working for Students for Life of America, Bethany now trains and mentors youth leaders across Europe. She has spoken at 100's of events across Europe, including the March for Life events in Denver, Berlin, Vienna, and Budapest and trained 100's of youth on pro-life action.



Timothy Hall and his wife Kristy played a crucial role in the birth of SaveOne Europe. They were the first to bring SaveOne to Europe, i.e. Slovenia, and then trained Sonja Horswell and helped her to get SaveOne off the ground in Austria. The rest is history! When Timothy was 20, his girlfriend chose to have an abortion without telling him first. Six years later, he was the first man to go through a SaveOne course.



Kristy Hall states, *“When my husband told me he needed to attend a SaveOne class my first response was confusion. He had not mentioned this part of his past to me before and obviously I was taken aback by what he was telling me. Sheila was so excited that I was there, and the things we discovered in those weeks were just as much for me as they were for Timothy.”*

Today Timothy and Kristy are the international liaison for SaveOne. Timothy and Kristy are passionate about spreading their testimony wherever they go. They have five sons and live in Michigan, United States.



Kristijan Aufiero is the President of Pro Femina e.V. and founder of the campaign 1000plus, which has the goal to expand Pro Femina's counselling and to spread the truth about women in crisis pregnancies. When 1000plus started in 2009, the association counselled 277 women. Ten years later in 2019, Pro Femina has counselled 15,400 women.



Paula von Ketteler started working for 1000plus right at the beginning of that campaign. After working for 1000plus in donor communication and fundraising, she is now in charge of international relations.

Pro Femina e.V. is a private association based in Germany which offers information, professional counselling and help through the internet to women in crisis pregnancies. In Pro Femina's experience, the majority of women facing an abortion do this against their own will, and because of the influence of other people and the often unfavourable circumstances. Through their counselling, Pro Femina enables these women to find their own strength again and gives them back their freedom to choose life without fears.

Our Megan Award Winner for 2020



Beate Wagner - Organisation Kaleb, Region Chemnitz e.V, in Germany

"I saw the light of day in the wild summer of '68, which was a tumultuous time in Europe! I grew up as the fourth child of a family of craftsmen in eastern Germany and had wonderful role models in my parents. They lived out their faith in Jesus Christ with simplicity and fidelity and served many people 'without regard for the person' - that has shaped me deeply for the future of my life.

I belong to a Christian church community here in Chemnitz and have been involved in their growth and development since joining them in 1990. In miraculous ways I received my Diploma as a Social Worker (FA) in 1992 - a degree which would have been unthinkable just a few years beforehand and which opened up so many possibilities for me.

My husband Christian and I were entrusted with 3 children and after an intensive family time in 2009 I received the offer to work as a pregnancy counsellor at the KALEB e.V. This is an association standing for the right to life founded in 1990 in the new federal states - another miracle.

Then, more than ever, I was confronted with challenging life stories and decisions and increasingly touched by the plight of women who have experienced an abortion. A breakfast at McDonalds with a special friend in January 2013 gave the decisive impetus to 'get on my way.' In the biggest snowstorm in March 2013 I went to a SaveOne training course. Since then I have been able to accompany many women through the course and discover in amazement how God interweaves our threads of life in a unique way and is at work in us!"

Anita Jovanović is the founder and director of the Pregnancy Help Centre, *Izaberi Zivot* („Choose Life”) in Croatia. Anita was born and raised in Daruvar, a small town in Northeast Croatia. She became a follower of Jesus in 2004.

In 2013 she founded *Izaberi Zivot*. Anita has even housed pregnant women in her home until they were able to move out on their own. Anita and her husband Nikola were married in 2009.

They are blessed to have three wonderful foster children - Andreja, Aleksandra and Denis. Anita and her husband also had the first child of their own in 2018.
